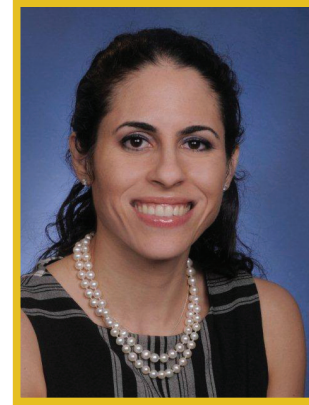


## **Gabrielle Solomon, MPH**
