

## **Steven Elliott Marcus, Ed.D.**

Dr. Marcus is President and CEO of Health Foundation of South Florida, a nonprofit grant making organization dedicated to improving health in Broward, Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties.

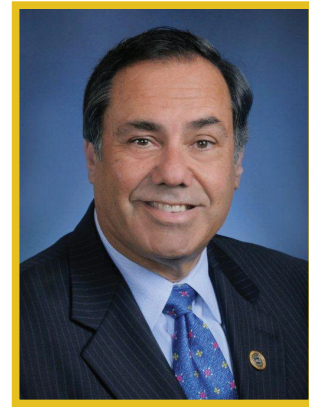
After Board approval to transform our grantmaking program, Dr. Marcus led the staff in implementing a responsive grant program based on four community focus areas, healthy eating active communities, preventive measures, primary care and oral health. Also under his leadership, the Foundation is driving a five year Strategic Initiative on Healthy Aging. Currently, new initiatives under development include organizing a Florida Convergence Partnership on Fresh Food Access, Innovating the Foundation's capacity to build a compete as a fiscal agent for new programs and projects including Health News Florida and supporting a new insurance coverage plan called Miami-Dade Blue.

He began his fund raising career as a capital campaign consultant for American City Bureau in Chicago, Illinois, which is also his hometown. Since that time he has served as a philanthropic development professional in higher education, visual arts and health care, and now as an executive in grantmaking and foundation management.

Dr. Marcus was previously Executive Vice President of the Mount Sinai Medical Center Foundation in Miami Beach, Florida where he had served for nearly 13 years.

Dr. Marcus received his Doctorate in Higher Education Administration from the University of Georgia in Athens, his Masters in Higher Education Student Personnel Administration from Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana and B.S. in Education from the University of Missouri in Columbia.

He currently serves as Chairman on the Board of the Florida Philanthropic Network and recently served on the Miami-Dade County Governance Task Force for Jackson Health System.
